**The June Mission Baskets** we are collecting for our Embrace Grace program.

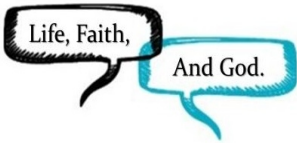




**Wednesday Prayer Services** at 7:30 p.m. at our 170 W. Davis Street location.
